Why Should I use LSZH not PVC?

Most network cables are insulated with polyethylene, PVC or Thermoplastic Urethane (TPU). In fires, a halogen-containing plastic material releases hydrogen chloride, a poisonous gas, this forms hydrochloric acid when it comes in contact with water. Designated Halogen-free cables, on the other hand, does not produce a dangerous gas/acid combination or toxic smoke when exposed to a flame.

Low Smoke Zero Halogen cable reduces the amount of toxic and corrosive gases emitted during combustion. These types of materials are typically used in poorly ventilated areas such as aircrafts or rail cars. Low smoke zero halogen is becoming very popular and in some cases a requirement in instances where the protection of people and equipment from toxic and corrosive gasses is critical.

Chances are your structured cabling network is LSZH but your patch leads are not!!!
